

Vintage Kids: Preschool Lead Teacher

Goal(s):

- To teach Biblical truths in relevant & creative ways to preschoolers
- To encourage & nurture preschoolers knowledge of the Bible and relationship with Jesus
- To be an example of an adult who loves & follows Jesus (so that kids see that following Jesus is the real deal, it's not only something that their parents do)
- To serve not only the preschoolers, but their whole family

What gifts/talents/skills are needed in this part of Vintage Kids ministry?

- A love for preschoolers
- The ability and willingness to communicate Biblical truths in preschool appropriate ways
- Classroom management skills
- · Flexibility- being able to monitor how things are going and adjust the activities accordingly
- Work well with a team

What are the individual responsibilities of the member?

- To intentionally care for & connect with the kids in our class while being an advocate for each child's emotional and physical safety
- Consistently pray for the kids you work with and their families
- Attend our prayer huddle before class starts to lift up the morning to the Lord as an entire team
- Be intentional about getting to know kids, their families & other Vintage Kids volunteers
- Follow weekly curriculum & schedule provided by Kids Director
- Teach the bible lesson in creative ways
- Instruct kids in activities & crafts
- Lead and train small group assistants
- Sanitize & disinfect surfaces
- Communicate to the Director of Kids Ministry any new ideas, encouraging stories, and feedback on how to improve the ministry

Time Investment: 2-2.5 hrs/week once a month

- Serve once a month at either the 9am or 11am gathering
- Arrive 30 minutes before gathering begins and stay 15 minutes after gathering ends
- To be well prepared for Sunday, you'll need to read and think through the activities on the lesson plan at home, which we send to you by email (10-15 mins)
- Attend team meetings for encouragement, brainstorming and training (6 meetings a year)
